Reverend Professor **Roman Malek SVD** was born on October 3, 1951, in Bytów (Western Kashubia). In 1969, he joined the Divine Word Society – starting from the Divine Word Missionaries Seminary in Pieniężno (Warmia). While studying philosophy and theology (1970-1976), he got interested particularly in the science of religions and issued a series of scientific articles in: „Collectanea Theologica”, „Anthropos”, „Przegląd Orientalistyczny” [*Orientalistic Review*], „Chrześcijanin w Świecie” [*A Christian in the World*], „W drodze” [*On the Road*], „Przewodnik Katolicki” [*Catholic Guidebook*] and others. In 1976, at the John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin, he defended his Master Thesis entitled *Nowa religia Japonii: Tenri-kio. Studium monograficzne ze szczególnym uwzględnieniem doktryny* [*A New Japanese Religion: Tenri-kio. A Monographic Study with a Special Attention to the Doctrine*] (supervisors: Rev. T. Chodździło SVD and Rev. H. Zimoń SVD) and took his holy orders to the priesthood (minister: Bishop B. Czapliński). He was then devoted to scientific assignments in the „Monumenta Serica” Sinological Institute in Sankt Augustin near Bonn. He completed studies in the science of religions and history, sinology and Japanese studies at the Bonn University. There, he gained the title of the Doctor of Philosophy in sinology (1984) and earned his habilitation (2002). He taught science of religions and sinology at the Theological Faculty in Sankt Augustin, at the Bonn University as well as other foreign higher institutes (among others, in the Philippines, Taiwan, Poland). Rev. Roman Malek SVD is a full member of the Asian Section of the Ambrosiana Academy in Milan. He initiated the foundation of the Michael Boym SJ „Sinicum” Society in Warsaw. In 1992-2012, he was the president of the Sinological Institute „Monumenta Serica” and the editor-in-chief of the following journals: „Monumenta Serica – Journal of Oriental Studies” (1992-2011), „Monumenta Serica Monograph Series” (1985-2012) and „Collectanea Serica” (1986-2012). He is an author, co-author, editor and publisher to a few hundreds of scientific publications in English, Chinese, German and Polish.
